Next Storybus Tour: June 22, 2013, departing from Writers Guild of America, West, Los Angeles, CA

Hollywood, Health & Society's next Storybus Tour on June 22 is an exclusive visit to a "Lost World"—The Nature Conservancy's 74-square-mile preserve on Santa Cruz Island inside Channel Islands National Park. The island, inhabited 13,000 years ago by pygmy mammoths and paleo-indians, has an incredible history, and more recently teetered on the brink of ecological collapse. The island visit will offer a glimpse of what Southern California used to be like in the distant past. We'll also speak with Conservancy scientists to learn about living a low impact, off-the-grid lifestyle in a remote environment.

Please note: The trip will be a 12-hour day—we'll be leaving the Writers Guild of America, West for Ventura Harbor at 7 a.m. and won't be returning until 7:30 p.m. The boat ride to Santa Cruz Island takes two hours, and the weather and ocean conditions in Santa Barbara Channel are unpredictable and can be rough. Once we're on the Island we'll be riding in jeeps and doing a lot of walking. HH&S will provide food and water, but we ask that you dress appropriately (bring hiking shoes, wear layers, bring sunscreen, etc.). There is no cell phone reception on the Island.
